



## Kroger Community Rewards Program

Pride Soccer Club is an enrolled 501c3 Organization with the Kroger Community Rewards Program. When you register online and shop at Kroger using your Kroger Plus Card, Pride Soccer Club will receive a % of your total grocery bill. At this time Kroger has suspended release of client's names to all 501c3 groups; in order to receive credit on your PSC Club Account you must send a screen shot of your account info from Kroger Community Rewards that will show your past quarter's earnings to our Club Administrator.

Please follow the instructions below to register:

- If you do not have a Kroger Plus Card, they are available at the Customer Service Desk at any Kroger.
- Even if you already have a Kroger Plus Card, you must re-enroll every year in April!
- Register online at [www.krogercommunityrewards.com](http://www.krogercommunityrewards.com)
- Have your Plus Card handy.
- Click on "Create an Account" and follow the prompts
- You will need to enter your zip code, an email address and create a password.
- You will then be instructed to go to your email inbox to complete the registration.
- When you log in, be sure to select Pride Soccer Club as the organization for your rewards.
- Our number is #83912
- To verify that you are enrolled correctly, you will see Pride Soccer Club on the right side of your information page.
- Remember, purchases will not count for us until after you register your card.

Payments to the Club will be quarterly.

Quarter 1: May 1 – July 31: Statements and donations sent by August 31<sup>st</sup>

Quarter 2: August 1 – October 31: Statements and donations sent by November 30<sup>th</sup>

Quarter 3: November 1 – January 31: Statement and donations sent by February 28<sup>th</sup>

Quarter 4: February 1 – April 30: Statement and donations sent by May 31<sup>st</sup>

These funds may be applied to outstanding Club Fee's, Additional Tournaments, Soccer Camp's & Indoor Soccer – any balance not used will carry over into the next season. **Rewards dollars earned are split with the club with the club's portion going toward training equipment for players.**

These funds cannot be used to pay for anything from another organization or business. If a player leaves the club the funds will revert back into the PSC General Fund.
