



## PSC Kroger Community Rewards Program Information:

- Register or re-register your Kroger Plus Card at [www.KrogerCommunityRewards.com](http://www.KrogerCommunityRewards.com)
- **Pride Soccer Club, #83912** – you can use the long name or number to search for the Charity – both work
- It takes 7-10 days for your organization to be attached to your card; you will know it's working when you see a message at the bottom of your receipt that states, "At your request, Kroger is making a donation to 'Pride Soccer Club'."
- Please use the registration form to give our Kroger Coordinator (Lisa Reade) the card holder's name, Kroger Plus Card Number & the player the funds should be dedicated to – this can be emailed to Lisa – [lreade@insight.rr.com](mailto:lreade@insight.rr.com) or mailed to the PO Box. Failure to do this will result in funds being applied to the PSC General Fund.
- This is a year to year program – you will be required to re-enroll by May of each year – after 4/1 Reward rate is variable – dependant on the number of groups that enroll in the program. Kroger will not pay out more than \$1,250,000 per quarter, individual card holders cannot earn more than \$300 per quarter.

What types of items are not included in the Kroger Rewards Program:

alcohol, tobacco, government-assisted pharmacy expenses, postage stamps, Kroger gift cards and Green Dot Prepaid Cards, gift certificates, bottle deposits, lottery and promotional tickets, fuel, fuel center purchases, office services and Sales Tax. Eligible pharmacy purchases include out-of-pocket co-pays for non-government-assisted pharmacy programs.

- Payments to the Club will be quarterly.
  - Quarter 1: May 1 – July 31: Statements and donations sent by August 31<sup>st</sup>
  - Quarter 2: August 1 – October 31: Statements and donations sent by November 30<sup>th</sup>
  - Quarter 3: November 1 – January 31: Statement and donations sent by February 28<sup>th</sup>
  - Quarter 4: February 1 – April 30: Statement and donations sent by May 31<sup>st</sup>

These funds may be applied to outstanding Club Fee's, Additional Tournaments, Soccer Camp's & Indoor Soccer – any balance not used will carry over into the next season. Rewards dollars earned are split with the club with the club's portion going in the General Fund.

These funds cannot be used to pay for anything from another organization or business. If a player leaves the club the funds will revert back into the PSC General Fund.
