



Pride Soccer Club Parent Code of Conduct

PSC Parents will be expected to:

1. Be a positive fan in all actions and words only giving encouragement and positive feedback
2. Refrain from giving instructions to players on the field (soccer is a player's game, let them figure it out)
3. Refrain from speaking to a referee at any time during or after a game
4. Refrain from speaking to opposing players and coaches at any time during or after a game
5. Be intelligent soccer fans by making an effort to learn and understand the rules and nuances of the game
6. Wait at least 24 hours after the conclusion of a game to talk to the coach about decisions made during the game
7. Be a role model for the players on the field
8. Represent the Pride Soccer Club with class and integrity
9. Attend the annual PSC clinic for parents

Failure to adhere to these expectations will result in:

1. Verbal warning by the coach
2. Suspension of parent for one game
3. Removal of parent/player from club without reimbursement of fees
